2010 Direct Funding Opportunities

Regional Club Development Program

As in 2009, regional clubs (those situated outside a major population area) have the opportunity to apply for direct funding from Golf Queensland to run participation programs.

Grants Application Assistance Program

Our Grants Application Assistance program (where clubs can apply for direct funding to complete state, council or community grants applications) proved extremely popular in 2009.

In conjunction with our grants partners Red Tape Busters, we have expanded this program for 2010 to allow more clubs the opportunity to have their grants applications professionally written and fully funded.

Golf Queensland would encourage all clubs to start planning their 2010 projects (in particular capital works projects which may be eligible for funding), including getting quotes where applicable.

The Grants Application Assistance Program will be released in early February.
